

## REQUIREMENTS FOR BROADS BOATERS

All vessels (including canoes, kayaks and SUPs) kept or used within the Broads Authority's navigation area, or adjacent waters, must have:

- EITHER an annual toll OR a short-visit toll paid in respect of them; for exceptions, registration and payment, apply to Broads Authority, Yare House, 62-64 Thorpe Road, Norwich, Norfolk NR1 1RY, tel: 01603 610734

- a valid Boat Safety Scheme Certificate (see page 139)
- the required third party insurance cover (except small unpowered vessels: see page 137).
