Broads Authority Electric Charging Points

These charging pillars are operated by a £1 payment card which can be bought from over 30 outlets throughout the Broads. A leaflet with maps locating Broads Authority charging pillars, and listing the card outlets, is available via their website – www.broads-authority.gov.uk, its information centres and yacht stations, and from card outlets.

Electric charging pillars can be found at Potter Heigham, Dilham Staithe, Sutton Staithe, Neatishead, Coltishall, Irstead Staithe, Hoveton, Horning, Ranworth, Acle Bridge, Stokesby, Great Yarmouth Yacht Station, Burgh Castle, St Olaves, Somerleyton, Reedham, Loddon, Hardley, Rockland Staithe, Bramerton, Whittingham and Norwich Yacht Station.

Listed below are roadside petrol stations within walking distance of moorings (some are more convenient than others).

Southern rivers:

Beccles

Morrisons on Beccles by-pass at George Westwood Way

Oulton Broad

Near Oulton Broad North railway station; also at Tesco on Beccles Road

Lowestoft

ASDA at Horn Hill, southwest of bridge

Norwich

Jet station on Rose Lane; Morrisons at Riverside

Northern rivers:

Great Yarmouth

Caister Road (walk upstream from yacht station); also at ASDA at Breydon Bridge

Acle

Roundabout at start of Acle straight

Wroxham

Junction Norwich/Salhouse Roads (moor upstream of bridges at Wroxham Village Moorings)

Coltishall

Village centre

Wayford Bridge

Smallburgh Road (towards Wroxham)

Stalham

Tesco on by-pass

Ludham (Womack)

High Street (closed on Sundays)

Potter Heigham

Repps, on Yarmouth Road

Provisions

Riverside stores are few in number, but do exist (eg – The Granary at Ranworth Staithe, Waveney River Centre, Riverside Tea Room & Stores at Stokesby, Lathams at Potter Heigham, the store at Acle Bridge, Horning Stores).

However, local pubs are filling the gap by selling provisions (eg – Cantley *Reedcutter*; Hickling *Pleasure Boat*).

A range of shops exist in the various small towns around the Broads and shops can still be found in many Broadland villages; indeed the White House Stores in Neatishead is open under community management as is the *White Horse* pub and shop in Upton. Please support local pubs and shops.
